

“Toyo Top Global Scholarship A” at Toyo University, Tokyo Japan
Full Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students (April 2017 intake)
- Pre-Arrival Foreign Students' Entrance Examination -

1. Establishment of Toyo Top Global Scholarship A <http://www.toyo.ac.jp/site/english-dp/108706.html>

In commemoration of the establishment of new faculties, Toyo University (Tokyo, Japan) <http://www.toyo.ac.jp/site/english/> has established a new scholarship program in which selected students from outside Japan are awarded a full tuition scholarship (tuition and all associated costs are waived) and living allowance of JPY150,000/month (JPY 1 nearly equals to KES 1) http://www.toyo.ac.jp/nyushi/pdf/admission/requirements/pre-arrival/pre-arrival-entrance-exam_2017_en.pdf (please see p.18 for details).

The anticipated total number of scholarship for student from abroad (not yet living in Japan) for April 2017 intake are **30 students** to be enrolled in the **Department of Global Innovation Studies**, **10 students** in the **Department of Regional Development Studies** and **10 Students** in the **Faculty of Information Networking for Innovation and Design**. Candidate students must have English level score among (TOEFL iBT79, PBT550, IELTS6.0, TOEIC 780). If above score is not available, English level should be evaluated by a public institution (e.g., an embassy, high school, or university) and signed on “English-Language Ability Certificate” https://www.toyo.ac.jp/nyushi/pdf/admission/requirements/pre-arrival/pre-arrival-entrance-exam_en-certificate_2017_en.pdf (If the applicant has received formal education in English for recent 6 years in Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, Singapore, UK or USA, please mention the fact on the certificate.)

2. Faculty of Global and Regional Studies

The Faculty <http://www.toyo.ac.jp/site/english-faculty/108208.html> includes two departments in which students can obtain bachelor's degree through courses offered in English.

Department of Global Innovation Studies (GIS) offers lectures related to economics, business and global collaboration whereas **Department of Regional Development Studies (RDS)** offers lectures related to international and regional development.

3. Application to Toyo University

Students who are 18 years of age or older as of March 31, 2017, and are scheduled to finish 12 years of formal education by that date are eligible for application. They should have enough English language proficiency to attend courses in English. Further information is available from the following sites:

4. Selection of students for scholarships

After the application has been submitted (application fee is JPY10,000), the following steps are taken.

- (1) Pre-selection of candidates through documents screening
- (2) Inform the detail of interview for pre-selected students
- (3) Interview of pre-selected students through a web-based conference system
- (4) Notification of results
 - Students selected as recipients of Toyo Top Global Scholarship A
 - Students selected but without Toyo Top Global Scholarship A (a partial tuition scholarship [30%] is awarded)
 - Students not selected

5. Conditions for the students selected for Toyo Global Scholarship A

- Transportation cost from your country dormitory (in Tokyo) shall be borne by the student.
- Students will be exempt from paying the enrollment fee, full tuition and all associated fees for four years.
- Students will receive a monthly sum of JPY150,000 to cover daily expenses and housing costs for four years for the first year, Toyo University will provide dormitories but the rent shall be covered by the students. From the subsequent year on, the students shall find their own housing with support from the university.
- Estimated monthly expenses in Tokyo are as follows:
Room JPY80,000, Food JPY50,000, Utility JPY5,000, Telephone JPY5,000, Other JPY10,000

NOTE: Scholarships will be awarded after the recipient has been admitted. If required academic standards are not maintained, the scholarships will be reduced or suspended after the second year. Any combination with other Toyo scholarships are not allowed.
