## Quantum Agriculture: Pathway to Resilient Agriculture Hugh Lovel and Shabari Bird



Hugh Lovel is a farmer, multidisciplinary scientist, teacher of soil science and biodynamics, and pioneer of the new science of Quantum Agriculture. Hugh gained broad experience in biodynamic farming while operating a market farm and the first CSA in Georgia. He migrated to Australia in 2005 to teach, consult and write, and serves on the national board of Biodynamic Agriculture Australia, the largest membership Biodynamic organization in the world. He also serves on the Standards Australia committee for Organic and Biodynamic Products which sets certification standards in Australia and for export. Hugh and his wife Shabari Bird Lovel are the founders of Quantum Agriculture Consultancy and live in Australia and the US.

Shabari is an expert in fermentation and has founded numerous schools including: The Native Wisdom School, the Gaia Institute and Sacred Drums of the Earth. She is passionate about the future of Agrohomeopathy and facilitates global conferences on the topic, and is also the widow of renowned author Christopher Bird: Secret Life of Plants, Secrets of the Soil.

Hugh aims to raise the level of scientific understanding of biology and agriculture where the intriguing rules of quantum physics are by far the best explanation of how living organisms interact with the soil as well as the wider universe.
